

225 added at bottom Read Matthew 9:1-8... verse 5: *For whether is easier to say thy sins be forgiven thee, or to say arise and walk?* What Jesus is saying here is "Which is easier to say - thy sins be forgiven, which this sickness is physically manifested because of, or to say, arise and walk." — or to say, "Which is easier? Wherein is the difference — to forgive sins which are the results of spiritual death in man's spirit, or to heal the disease of his physical body, which is the result also of the same spiritual death?" In either case, Jesus was dealing with the bondage of man to Satan.
